Important Requirements to Note When Applying for a Lottery Licence:

- 1. Licence Fee due Upon Approval of Application. The lottery licence fee is 3% of the total prize amount.
- 2. Licence Application process is a minimum of seven (7) days after all necessary information has been received by the Clerk.
